

All repairs for service pipes and plumbing systems of buildings shall be made by and at the expense of the owners of the premises served. The Town of Woodworth Utility System may in case of an emergency, repair any service pipes and if this is done the cost of repair work shall be repaid by the owner of the premises served.

Excavations for installing or repairing service pipes shall be made in compliance with the code provisions relating to making excavations in streets. Provided, that it shall be unlawful to place any service pipe in the same excavation with or directly over, any drain pipe or sewer pipe.

The User agrees to pay for Water Gas Garbage Sewer at such rates, time, and place as shall be determined by the Town of Woodworth Utility System, and agrees to the penalties for noncompliance with the above as set forth by the Town of Woodworth Utility System. Utility Users associated with the Town of Woodworth Utility System where meter assemblies have been installed will be charged a minimum fee regardless of actual usage or connection status.

The Town of Woodworth Utility System shall install a cutoff valve and also include a Water Gas meter in each service. The Town of Woodworth Utility System shall have exclusive right to use such cutoff valve and Water Gas meter.

The Town of Woodworth Utility System shall have final jurisdiction in any question of location of any service line connection to its distribution system; shall determine the allocation of Water Gas to Users in the event of a Water Gas shortage; may shut off Water Gas to a User who allows a connection or extension to be made to his or her service line for the purpose of supplying Water Gas to another User. In the event the total Water Gas supply shall be insufficient to meet all the needs of the Users, or in the event there is a shortage of Water Gas, the Town of Woodworth Utility System may pro-rate Water Gas available among the various Users on such basis as is deemed equitable by the Town of Woodworth Utility System.

The Town of Woodworth Utility System shall have final jurisdiction in any question of location of any Water Meter Gas Meter Sewer Pipelines.

Utility payments are due by the 5th of each month. After the 5th, there will be a 10% late fee assessed to the account. If payment is not received by the 15th of the month, utilities are subject to be disconnected. When disconnection occurs, the current amount due, past due amount as well as reconnect fees must be paid before service can be restored.

Where Water Gas Sewer has been cut off or disconnected for nonpayment of a bill, temporarily disconnected at the request of a customer or for other reasons, there shall be a charge for reconnection of \$35.00 during normal working hours and \$45.00 at all other times. This charge shall be added to the utility bill.

A disconnect fee of \$35.00 will be charged for each utility service on the final utility billing.
